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

Budgets Are Statement of Values – If you are truly addressing Racial Equity and Supporting Student Success, it will be reflected in your Institutional Budget and through your Institutional Budget Allocations

- Knowledge Understanding the data/research; reading important reports/documents; asking the right questions; and if you don't know the answer, asking for clarification.
- **Clear Vision** Having a vision for where you want your institution will be in the future.
- Building Support Identifying individuals to work with you; then those individuals are involved in the development; and they maintain their involvement in the work.

- Staying Focused Focus on what matters, which is -- Student Success.
- Using Data to Support Decision Making Don't make decisions on the fly that impact student success.
- Build Capacity Support all levels within your program/department and at your institutions.

- Opportunity Seize the moment and recognize the opportunities that will transform our institutions in support of student success.
- Never Give Up If we don't support and advocate for our students and our institutions, who will?
- Knowing when to hold back Pushing back or not implementing projects and initiatives for the institution to remain focused on the current mission, vision, and strategic initiatives.

- Ability to respond to criticism, discrimination, and racism Understand the difference between the three, and how to respond.
- **Be Kind** Saying "thank you" to everyone and showing genuine appreciation for the work that is occurring within our program/department and at our institutions.


